Biographical Note:

Jack C. Gallalee (1918-1974), a native of Tennessee, received his law degree from the University of Alabama and practiced law in Mobile, Alabama, with the firm Caffey, Gallalee, and Eddington. He served in the US Army, 1941-1946, and was a member of the Alabama House of Representatives, 1950-1954, and commissioner on the Mobile County School Board, 1961-1965.

Scope and Contents:

Personal files of Jack Gallalee, former school board member, containing correspondence, publications, and minutes of the Mobile County School Board, 1961-1965. Includes many pamphlets. Subjects range from federal educational mandates regarding integration to problems relating to fraternities and sororities in the Mobile County school system. Also donated numerous books.
